### PROCLAMATION

**WHEREAS,** the 56<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the National Fair Housing Law, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, during the month of April, is an occasion for all Americans – individually and collectively – to rededicate themselves to the principle of freedom from housing discrimination whenever it exists; and

**WHEREAS,** this law guarantees for each citizen the critical, personal element of freely choosing a home; and

**WHEREAS,** a fair housing law has been passed by the State of Louisiana; and implementation of that law requires the positive commitment, involvement and support of all our citizens; and

**WHEREAS,** the department and agencies of the State of Louisiana are to provide leadership in the effort to make fair housing not just an idea, but an ideal for all our citizens; and

**WHEREAS,** barriers that diminish the rights and limit the options of any citizen to freely choose a home will ultimately diminish the rights and limit the options of all:

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Randy Delatte, President of the Livingston Parish Council, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2024, as:

### FAIR HOUSING MONTH

in Livingston Parish, Louisiana, and do hereby encourage all citizens to abide by the letter and spirit of the Fair Housing Law and ask the citizens of Livingston Parish to join in reaffirming the obligation and commitment to fair housing opportunities for all.
