**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AN AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLAN AS
REQUIRED UNDER THE LOUISIANA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK/MITIGATION (CDBG/MIT) PROGRAM**

MOTION was made by Randy Delatte and duly seconded by Shane Mack and carried
unanimously that the following resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish Government is a subrecipient receiving Louisiana State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, as administered by the Louisiana Office of Community Development (OCD) of the Louisiana Division of Administration (DOA) to assist in addressing mitigation and unmet needs; and,

WHEREAS, participation in the Louisiana CDBG Program requires the adoption and implementation of an Affirmative Action Plan to meet the Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) requirements of Executive Order 11246 and other program policies; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of this plan is to prohibit workplace employment discrimination on the basis of age, race, color, religion, gender, creed, national origin, physical or mental disability, marital status, veteran status, disabled veteran status, or status as a member of any other protected group or activity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Livingston Parish Council that the attached Affirmative Action Plan be hereby officially adopted for implementation in the Livingston Parish Government's Louisiana CDBG/MIT Program.


